What is our Co-op Cares Projects Initiative?

Borderland Co-operative Limited is proud to be able to support new projects in the communities that we serve. When our customers support us through purchases, we are able to give back to the community by helping with bigger projects to improve the quality of life of our members.

Your project committee will purchase the materials required from our Co-op and in return, we will provide a percentage of cash back on your purchases payable to the organization when the project is complete. This will be between 15 & 20% based on purchased materials.

How do our projects qualify for this initiative?

You must first obtain a product quote with the help of our home centre staff, then apply for sponsorship by completing the form below. Please return the form to Borderland Co-op Admin Office. Depending on the magnitude of the sponsorship/donation, it may be reviewed at the next board meeting to be approved by our board of directors.

After approval, you will be contacted by email to advise you that the project has been approved.

At the end of your project, the Home Centre will print off a list of purchases and your cash back will be calculated accordingly. Subsequently, a cheque will be presented.

If the donation is larger than \$1000, a cheque presentation will take place and be advertised in our local paper.
